  - o Currently closing out fiscal year. Reconciliation of a few line items will take place over the next two months.
- July Statement of Revenues and Expenses:
  - o Rides and attractions revenue is down, however there is a price increase that will go into effect on September 1
  - o Classes and programs revenue is down due to birdhouse closure and new sea lion acclimation period. We should see that pick up soon.
  - o Department expenditures were low to offset slower revenues.
